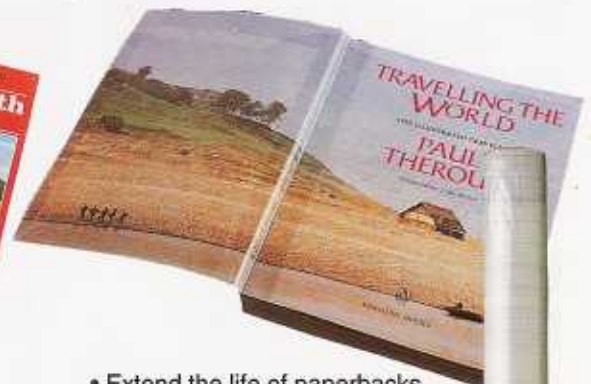

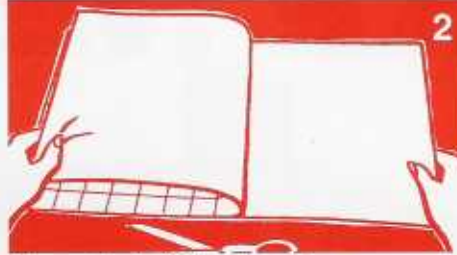

BOOK COVERING FILM HANDY APPLICATION HINTS



1 Unroll to the approximate length required, with the backing side up. Lay the open book over it and cut out allowing 3.5cm all around.



2 Separate half the backing paper by peeling it to the centre. Line up the edges and crease it in half.



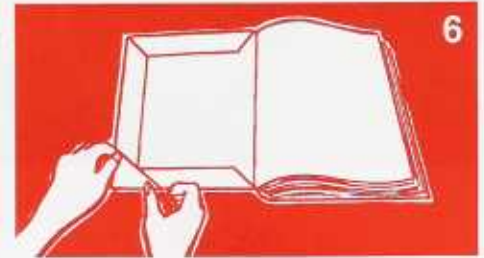
3 Lay the centre of the book's spine along the crease then carefully rotate the books cover onto the adhesive surface.



4 Trim off the corners and make cuts in towards the spine as illustrated. Retain the off-cuts for reinforcing the corners (step 6).

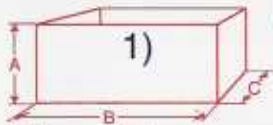


5 Starting from the centre of each edge, fold the flaps over the cover. Trim off excess at spine.

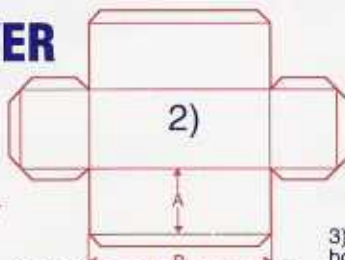


6 Remove the remaining backing paper and repeat steps 4 and 5 for the other cover, then seal the corners using the off-cuts saved in step 4.

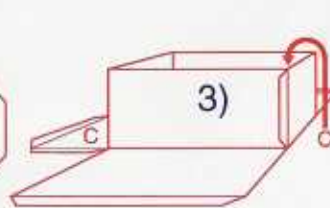
HOW TO COVER BOXES



1) Measure the length, width and height of the box.



2) Mark these measurements onto VenCover, allowing 3.5cm for the overlaps, then cut out.

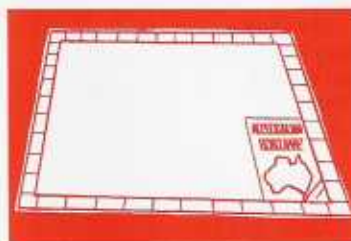
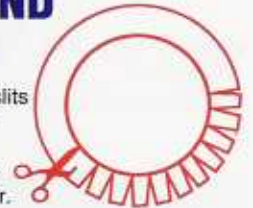


3) Peel off the backing and place the bottom of the box onto the adhesive surface. Starting with the surfaces marked "C" on the illustration, carefully smooth VenCover onto the box.

HOW TO MAKE NEAT CIRCLES AND CORNERS

1) Cut evenly spaced slits through the overlap of VenCover as shown.

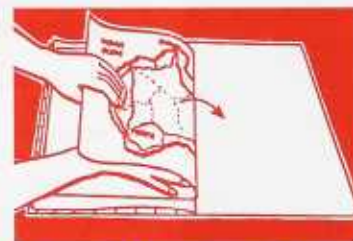
2) Fold the flaps neatly over the edge or corner.



1. Ensure map is clean and has no creases or wrinkles. Before removing backing paper, cut to approximate size allowing 2cm all around.



2. With the backing side up, separate half the backing paper by peeling it to the centre. Line up the edges and crease it in half.



3. Lay the centre of the map along the crease then carefully smooth the map onto the adhesive surface, a little at a time, working from the centre outwards.



4. Remove the remaining backing paper and smooth down the other half of the map in the same way; then using a sharp hobby knife, trim the film flush with map edges.
